<b>Volunteer Role:</b>	Play and Youth Swim Club Volunteer
<b>Location</b>	Guildford
<b>Commitment:</b>	Our hope is that our Swim volunteers will either volunteer for 100 hours or stay with us for 3 to 6 months. The club runs on Saturdays for 2 hours (4pm-6pm) A DBS enhanced check will be carried out.
<b>Role Requirements:</b>	<p>The general role of swim club volunteers is to support the Swim Teacher, staff and other volunteers operating at Swim Club. We look for friendly and enthusiastic people who want to support the children and young people that we have swimming with us to enable them to have a fun filled and enjoyable time.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To support the Swim Teachers and other volunteers in the care and supervision of children and young people who attend Challengers Swim Club – encouraging and supporting children to fully realise their abilities and providing a safe and happy play environment.</li> <li>2. Be a team member, supporting others volunteering and working at Challengers swim club.</li> <li>3. Help us to get children ready for swimming and get changed after swimming if required.</li> <li>4. Attend training sessions and meetings that are needed to carry out the role.</li> <li>5. Support the team to comply with the Health and Safety at Work Act (information available from Challengers).</li> <li>6. Report any concern about a child’s welfare or safety in accordance with Challengers Safeguarding Policy and Procedure.</li> <li>7. To conduct yourself and represent the Charity in a manner which reflects all the values and principles of The Challengers Approach.</li> </ol>
